KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Kindergarten registration applications for children born in 2019, turning 5 in 2024, will take place between January 22 and February 2, 2024.

Registration will be an online form and will be available on our Registration Page on January 22. If you are unable to complete this online form at home, laptops will be made available for legal parents/guardians at schools.

To register your child, the parent or legal guardian must provide the school with the following:

- Your child's original birth certificate, any applicable immigration documents, and/or proof of Canadian citizenship for both you and your child.
- Your child's BC Health Care Card or proof of a submitted application if you are new to the province of BC.
- Proof of your residence address (a document such as your current year property tax receipt, current month rental receipt, or a purchase/rental agreement).

Note: Parents are required to have their children registered for school or homeschooling by the calendar year in which they turn six. If parents choose to defer school enrolment for their five-year-old, they should discuss this choice with the school principal in order to determine the best placement for their child.
